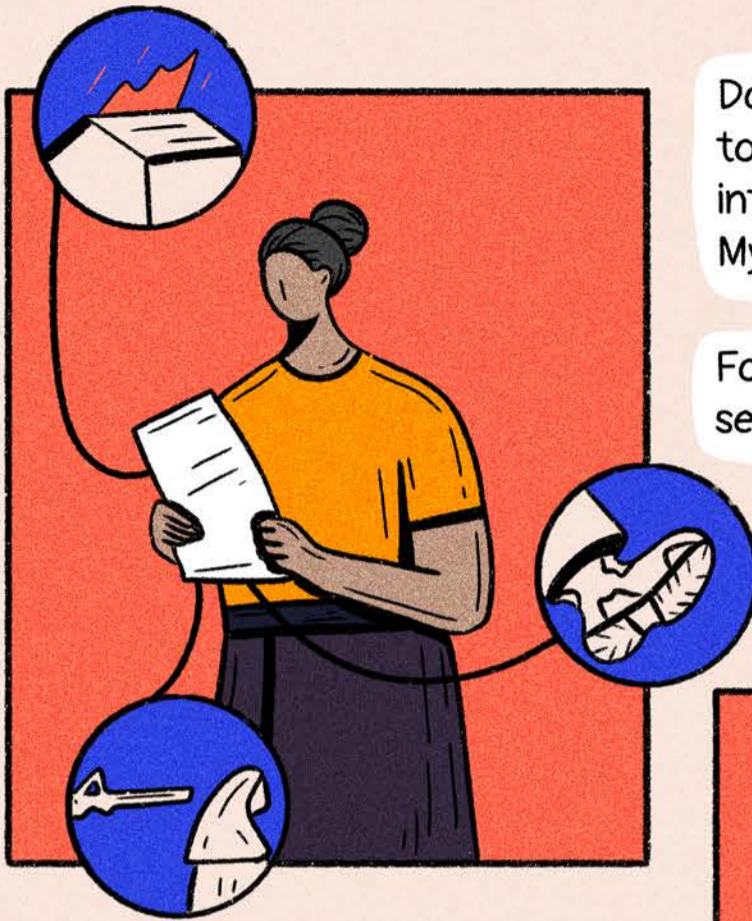


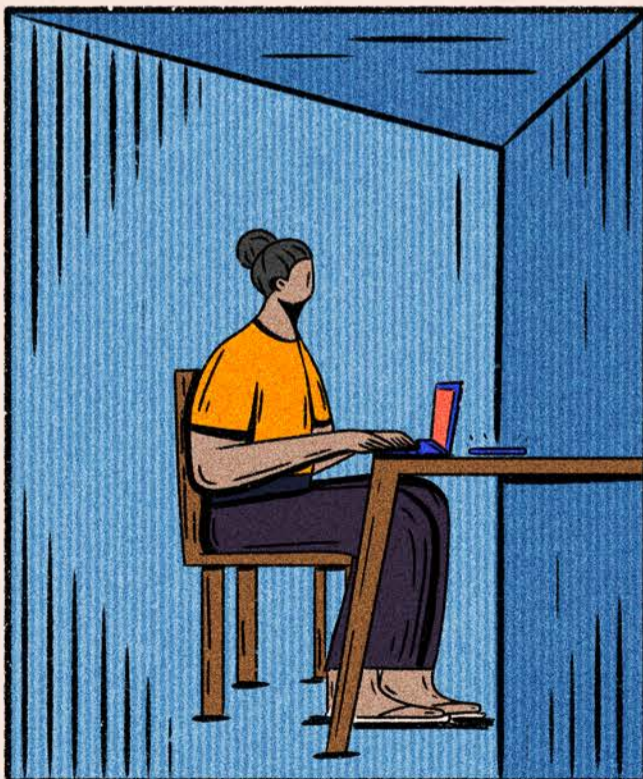
# How to contact IIMM securely



Do you have confidential information to share with IIMM about serious international crimes committed in Myanmar?

Follow these steps to contact us securely.

First, wait until you are safe and alone to make contact.



Do not tell anyone, even your friends and family, you are contacting us.

You can share material in any language and in any format. Send us a message and we will guide you on how to share videos, documents and other confidential material, which will be stored securely in an encrypted database.





Tell us if you have additional concerns about your safety. We will only contact you if it is safe to do so.



Next, our investigators, lawyers and specialists will analyze your material. We can only give you general feedback on how it is used to build cases because criminal investigations must be kept confidential.

We do not share your information, or any details about your identity, without your consent.
